

## Paris Art Residency: Studio of Qatar

### Application Terms and Conditions

Please ensure that you are aware of all Terms and Conditions before you apply for the Artist in Residence Program, Studio of Qatar, at the Cite Internationale des Arts Paris France.

- The application to the Paris Art Residence Program is open to Qatari artists aged 18 and above, in all artistic disciplines and practices.
- Applicants are not required to have any formal or academic training in the Arts (i.e. BFA or MFA). Self-taught artists are equally eligible to apply to the residency program.
- The first residency program will run for a period of 3 months commencing in December 2016 and ending in March 2017 with a mandatory art piece to be created during their stay at the residency OR to be able to give a talk about their experience at the Cite Internationale des Arts Paris France.
- A panel of esteemed judges will review all applicants. All applicants will be notified via email about the jury's final decision regarding the selected artists.
- When applying, the artist should make sure to:
  - Download and print the PDF version of the application to be manually filled out by applicant.
  - Download and print the PDF checklist accompanying the application to ensure all necessary documents are submitted to the Fire Station.
  - Applicant to present a body of work that most accurately represents their current art practice.
  - Submit high-resolution prints if applicant wishes to share any photographic work.
  - All videos must be submitted on an accompanying USB stick
  - Provide a clear list of titles and media.

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- It would be preferred if work can be organized in chronological order for the jury to follow the artist's progression and growth.
- Applicant must complete the application form in full; along with the checklist, and hand deliver it to the Fire Station. The application form and checklist will now serve the purpose of a cover page with all submitted works being placed behind them.
- We request that everything is put into a folder with a label on top stating the applicant's name, phone number, and date of submission.

### General Residency Guidelines

- The artist will have access to printmaking and photography workshops at the Cite Internationale des Art, as well as a free entry pass to the museums of the city of Paris and certain national museums.
- The artist will be solely responsible for the upkeep and safeguarding of their studio space and the Cite Internationale des Art not responsible for any objects or materials left in the studio.
- In the case of untimely termination or departure from the residency program, the artist is requested to inform Fire Station Senior Management.
- Fire Station and Qatar Museums will not be responsible in giving accepted applicants exemptions from work or studies. Fire Station and Qatar Museums will not be responsible in processing Schengen Visa. However the Fire Station will be able to provide letters attesting to the artists participation in the program for his/her perusal as proof of his/her attendance and participation in the Paris Art Residency Program, Studio of Qatar.
- Upon completion of the residency, artists are required to donate a minimum of one artwork to the Fire Station, OR to give a public talk about their experience and insights gained at the Cite Internationale des Arts Paris. This helps Fire Station to build a collection, which we will proudly display for years to come.

*The jury is allowed to, at any time, call any applicant in for an interview to further garner an understanding of their project, experience and/or intent. However, an interview is not guaranteed a position, nor does it suggest other applicants won't be accepted to partake in the residency.*
